### KEN MORONEY AO

#### "The Greatest Influence in Reducing Crime and Anti-social Behaviour"

During his 42 years of service from 1965 Ken held many positions, culminating in the role of Commissioner of Police for NSW between 2002 and 2007, the year he retired. Since then, he has served on numerous boards including chairman of the Board of Management – Aust. Graduate School of Policing and Security; Judicial Commission of NSW; Law Enforcement Advisory Panel; NSW Police Legacy..... and many other roles. Not a day goes by when we watch the evening news on TV, or read the day's newspaper, that crime and anti-social behaviour are not in the news a reminder that crime and anti-social behaviour affect us all.

Whose responsibility is it? Is it solely a matter for governments at local, state and national levels? Do we need more police? Do penalties play a part in reducing crime and anti-social behaviour? Should we build more gaols? Whatever the solutions, some are right on our door step. That's the focus of today's discussion.

### LA PEROUSE MUSEUM Tour Wednesday 21st November 2018

La Perouse Museum is located on Kamay Botany Bay National Park's northern headland. The museum is housed within the historic Cable Station building, once Australia's only link to the rest of the world. The La Perouse Monument is located nearby. Almost 2,000 items across several rooms of exhibits document the 1787-1788 expedition of French explorer the Comte de Lapérouse. Items include the complete *Atlas of the Voyage of La Perouse*.



Lapérouse arrived in Botany Bay just a week after the First Fleet.

His expedition was last seen in what is now national parkland before mysteriously vanishing. The fascinating exhibits in the La Perouse Museum also tell stories of the local area, including Aboriginal tales.

Cost is \$12 per person to cover the coach hire. Lunch is at a cafe nearby at your own expense. The coach carries a maximum 30 passengers; numbers already exceed the coach limit but there are always cancellations. Contact Bob:
