“THE ANTARCTIC FESTIVAL”



The only event of its kind in Australia, the biennial Australian Antarctic Festival brings Antarctica to the Hobart waterfront. The Festival provides visitors with the opportunity to board and inspect the nation's research and supply vessels and enjoy a fascinating program of Antarctic science and discovery.

This year the festival was to run from 29 July to 3 August to coincide with two major international conferences; the Scientific Committee for Antarctic Research (SCAR) and the Council of Managers of National Antarctic Programs (COMNAP). It would bring 1200 delegates from 18 countries together to showcase and celebrate Hobart as Australia's gateway to Antarctica.

Owing to circumstances well beyond their control, organisers were compelled to announce a postponement of the Australian Antarctic Festival for 2020.
