



## **Joadja Creek Heritage Tour** **Wednesday 18th March 2026**

Join us for the day visiting the historic town, refinery and shale mines of Joadja, once home to 1,200 Scots in the 1800s. Our tour guide will explain the fascinating history of its ruins, retorts, mining shelves, railway and inclines. Joadja town is set on 800 acres of glorious parkland and is a fascinating industrial archaeological site that is listed on the NSW Heritage register and arguably the most important and relevant heritage site in the Southern Highlands of NSW.

Located west of Mittagong, we will enjoy the beauty of the surrounding ecology, flora and fauna as we travel south and arrive in time for morning tea. Our two hour tour is provided using people movers which will take us through the ruins of a time gone by and brings alive this extraordinary window into this part of Australia's heritage.

Lunch is provided at Joadja and consists of a selection of rolls (eg. chicken & salad, ham & salad & vegetarian), fruit, tea, coffee, juice and soft drink. After lunch we will continue on with a tour and tasting at the Whisky Distillery where you will see how single malt whisky, rum, brandy and dry gin are made and get to sample the products.

On the way home, we will also stop at the Darrell Lea Outlet, where you can browse a wide range of famous chocolates, liquorice and sweet treats at great outlet prices — the perfect way to end the day.
